Sendai Five Commitments

1. Raise Awareness: with respect to disaster risk and mobilization of the private sector;
2. Influence: in respective spheres of expertise;
3. Share Knowledge: experience and good practices amongst the private sector;
4. Be a Catalyst: to generate strategy, innovation and collaboration;
5. Implement: projects and activities to achieve the Sendai Framework targets

Prevent new, and reduce existing risk and strengthen resilience to natural and manmade hazards in order to achieve substantial reductions in disaster losses.

Priority 4: Enhancing disaster preparedness to “**Build Back Better**” in recovery, rehabilitation and *reconstruction*

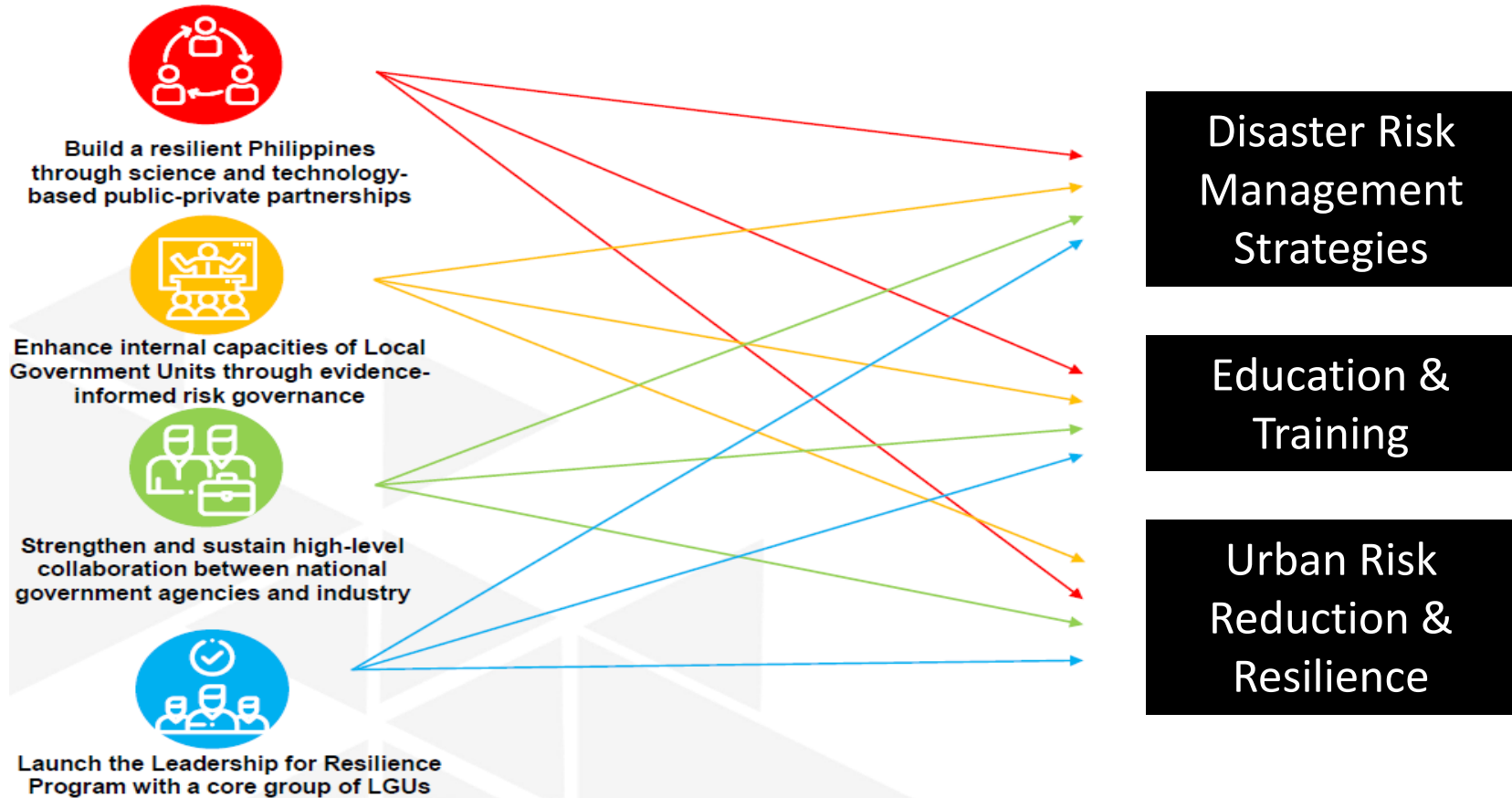
ARISE Networks

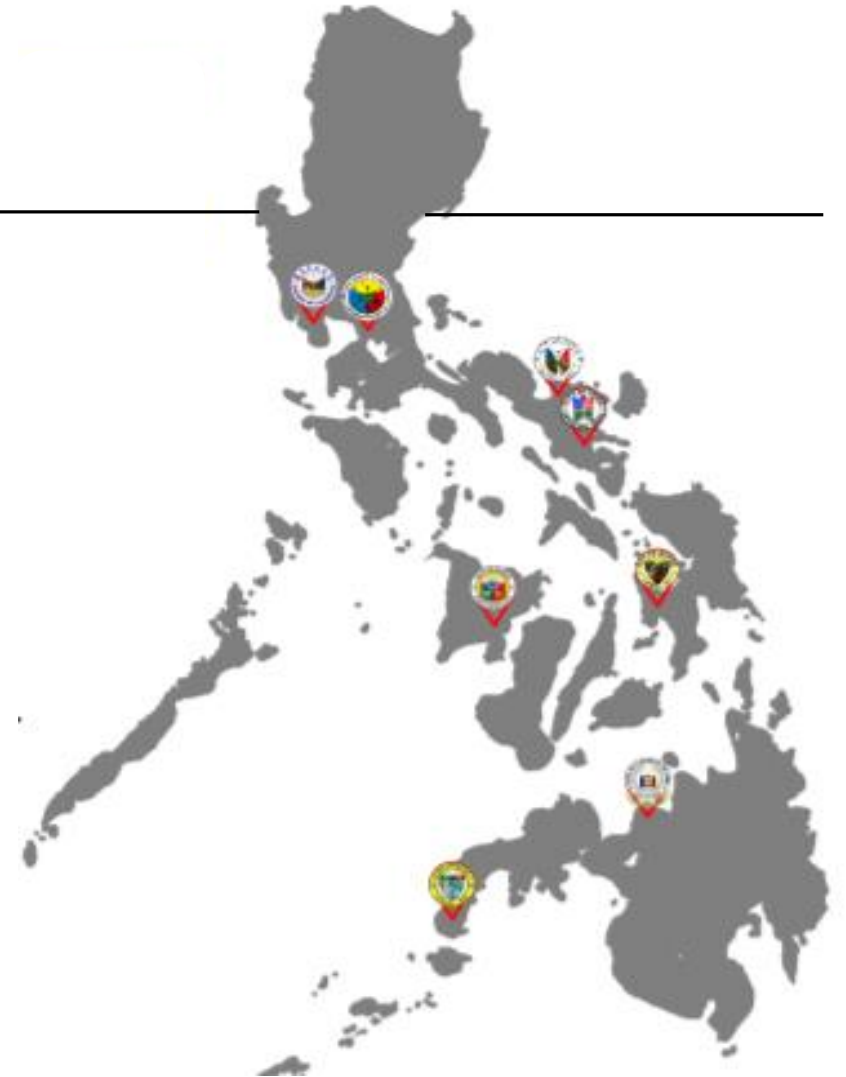


